Notice of Claim of Right and Estoppel By Acquiescence

Notice to principle is notice to agent and notice to agent is notice to principle.

Whereas I wrote to you on 16th April giving you notice that I did not understand the apparent demands you had made upon me and therefore could not lawfully fulfill them without further clarification.
